

Drawing on national qualification frameworks, ECTS credits shall be based on:

1. The hours of academic development.
2. The time allocated to individual or group work (homework, study, writing projects, practical work).
3. Time for preparation and conduct of the evaluation process.
4. Internships mandatory.

The faculty will define the learning outcomes of each component of the program, activities and workload that a student will need to perform the activities. With the data provided by the students and the host partner, will be awarded the appropriate number of credits.

Professionals in business practices are part of the learning outcomes and must be included in the allocation of credit. In this case, the number of commitments for professional practices, will add to the total count of the academic year credit.

Learning outcomes must be accompanied by the methods and criteria for evaluation. These should be reflected on a Europass Mobility document. These results are recognized by granting additional ECTS.
